- 2. An additional \$300 per person required for ASA-104 or ASA-106 certification. This option includes text book, daily training, review, testing, and certification. Course prerequisites must be met: ASA-104 requires completion of ASA 103; ASA 106 requires completion of ASA 104 and ASA 105
- Note 1: Cruisers will depart and return to Little Harbor Marina (Ruskin, FL—near Tampa) and should plan their air/ground travel accordingly.
- Note 2: Does not include air fare and other transportation/hotel costs. Meals and drinks ashore are responsibility of individual crew member.
- Note 3: Your deposit of 50% must be made no later than 60 days prior to trip. Balance must be received no later than 30 days prior to trip.
